<p>Violation #36. Thermometers provided &amp; accurate No thermometer in McCall reach-in refrigerator #3. Provide thermometer in reach-in refrigerator.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Thermometers must be calibrated to ensure accuracy in accordance with Rule requirements. Food thermometers scaled in Celsius (C) shall be accurate to plus or minus 1°C or in Fahrenheit (F), accurate to plus or minus 2°F. Food thermometers should be accessible for use by employees and have a probe size appropriate to the food item.</p>
<p>Violation #47. Food &amp; non-food contact surfaces Rusted fan observed above the sanitize compartment sink. Replace fan with rusts to prevent contamination of food and utensils.</p> <p>The vent of the air curtain at the receiving area has accumulated dust. Clean out dust on vent.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.</p>
<p>Violation #56. Ventilation &amp; lighting Burnt out light bulbs in the following locations: * Ventilation hood system. * Above the serving line. * In the ware washing area.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>

At the time of inspection, the following violations from previous inspection were observed to have been corrected:

- #51. Missing backflow prevention device on the mop sink.
- #55. Ceiling tiles with black spots located in the dry food storage

Temperatures were taken with thermopen thermometer as follows:

- Handwash sink : 110-118°F
- Utility/Mop sink: 115°F
- Wash compartment of the 3-compartment sink: 133°F
- Reach in refrigerator: 27-30°F
- Reach in freezer: -8/5°F
